Position Description:

Education Interns will receive a breadth of knowledge in all aspects of museum operations. 15 hours per week supporting the Education Department. Interns will build professional skills and develop projects based on their interests as well as the needs of the organization.

- Facilitate the Field Trip experience for children ages pre K–12 years of age in our multimedia exhibit spaces
- Work with Educators and ZeumMasters during General Admission hours to teach basic, intermediate and advanced art and technology skills to youth and families
- Prepare, maintain and troubleshoot equipment and supplies in the exhibit/production areas; identify and report status of exhibits and supplies
- Document the safety and maintenance needs of exhibits
- Responsible for opening and closing the museum floor and reporting on all issues related to running the museum.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Strong interest in fine art, art history, arts administration, education, museum studies, or media studies strongly desired
- Experience working with children PreK-12 required.
- Strong computer skills on both Macs and PCs, working knowledge of media arts applications and the ability to learn and teach new software
- Strong written and oral communication skills

- Experience working with families and community groups, particularly in the San Francisco Bay Area strongly desired
